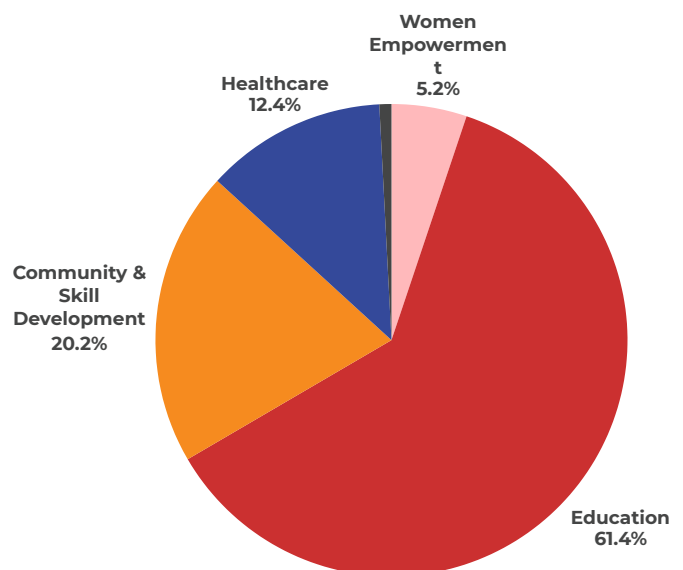

PROGRESS TOWARDS SUSTAINABLE CHANGE

- Positively impacted 4,821 beneficiaries during the reporting quarter through integrated, community-driven interventions.
- Established two STEM laboratories in government schools, enabling experiential learning and strengthening students' scientific understanding through hands-on education.
- Advanced the mainstreaming of women in policing through structured gender-sensitization trainings across 24 districts, reaching 900+ personnel via female-only, male-only, and mixed-group learning modules.
- Delivered primary healthcare services through general health check-up camps across 7 rural villages in S.A.S Nagar, enhancing access to early diagnosis, preventive care, and essential medicines for underserved populations.
- Extended targeted health interventions to 601 additional beneficiaries through health camps focused on addressing iron and vitamin deficiencies, particularly among women, alongside provision of basic medical support.
- Strengthened adolescent girls' health outcomes through anemia screening, health assessments, and menstrual hygiene awareness initiatives.
- Enabled sustainable livelihoods for 250+ women through the Hartek Skill Lab (Daun, PSRLM), collectively producing over 50,000 uniforms, thereby contributing to household income generation and economic resilience

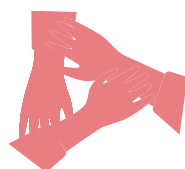

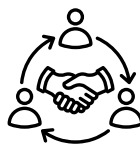

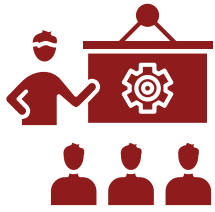

WHAT WAS DONE

Hartek Foundation in collaboration with CAD Punjab Police & JPAL South Asia conducted statewide gender sensitization training aimed at mainstreaming PPMMs. The program was delivered across three cohorts : Male Only, Female Only & Mixed Groups to ensure inclusive participation. Training occurs in 3 structured rounds to reinforce learning and institutional impacts.

WHY IT MATTERS

Embedding a gender perspective within the Punjab Police frameworks is essential for achieving equitable & inclusive development. This initiative supports behavior change , enhances awareness & strengthens the ability of the institution to address gender specific challenges effectively.

WHAT WAS DONE

In partnership with the Community Affairs Division and Punjab Intelligence, a comprehensive review & training session was conducted for officers across the Ropar & Patiala ranges to roll out standardized SOPs for the Yuva Saanjh initiative.

WHY IT MATTERS

This initiative is a critical shift toward preventive and restorative policing. By focusing on counseling, skill development, and employment, Yuva Saanjh addresses the root causes of youth delinquency and guides them toward constructive paths.

WHAT WAS DONE

Hartek Foundation, in collaboration with FPAI Mohali, organized a series of health camps in rural areas to strengthen access to primary healthcare services. The camps included vital health check-ups, screening for iron and vitamin deficiencies, and the provision of essential medicines. Special emphasis was placed on women's reproductive health, including HIV and Hepatitis C testing, along with appropriate medical support and counselling.

WHY IT MATTERS

These camps removed barriers to healthcare by enabling early disease detection and providing life-saving medical referrals, ensuring that distance and cost do not prevent vulnerable populations from receiving timely treatment.

Organized a health and awareness camp in Village Landran, delivering comprehensive anemia testing and medical screenings, along with focused menstrual hygiene workshops in partnership with FPAI, Mohali.

By combining diagnostic care with essential education, this initiative dismantled social taboos & addressed nutritional deficiencies, empowering young women with the tools & confidence to prioritize their long-term health & personal dignity.
